Fire Restriction Order (Stage 2)

Due to current and fore-casted weather conditions coupled with the extremely dry conditions, it has been determined that measures must be taken to prevent the ignition of forest and rangeland fires. Therefore, the Town of Tropic has prohibited the following acts in the areas described:

- Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire or campfire is prohibited, including charcoal grills, pellet grills, or ash-producing fuel. Properly shielded gas or liquid-fueled portable camp stoves with a shut-off valve are allowed, so long as there is at least three feet in diameter that is barren with no flammable vegetation.
- Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle, camp trailer, or building, a developed recreation site, or while stopped in an area that is paved or free from dry vegetation.
- Discharging or using any kind of fireworks (Utah Code § 15A-5-202.5(1)(b))
- Discharging or using any tracer ammunition, or other pyrotechnic devices, including exploding targets.
- Cutting, welding, or grinding metal in areas of dry vegetation.
- Operating a motorcycle, chainsaw, ATV, or other small internal combustion engine without an approved and working spark arrestor.

What is ALLOWED in Stage 2:

Note: A pressurized water system must be in place on unincorporated state and private lands, the entire incorporated Town of Tropic Boundaries, **including** campgrounds.

1. Persons with a permit or waiver specifically issued by the fire chief authorizing a specified act at a specific location. A waiver does not relieve the permittee of liability if a fire does occur.
2. A pressurized water system must be in place. Pressurized Fuel Devices: Devices using pellets, pressurized liquid, or gas (stoves, grills, or lanterns) that include shutoff valves when used in an area at least three feet or more from flammable material such as grasses, brush, weeds, or pine needles.
3. Any on-duty firefighter performing an official duty.

**Violations of this order will be punishable by law according to The Town of Tropic
